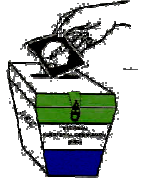

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION FOR VOTER ON POLLING DAY

- Remember that you vote where you registered!
- You need your Voter ID card to vote! Do not give your voter ID card to anyone! Please remember to bring it with you when you come to the polling centre. NEC polling staff will direct you to one of the polling stations in the polling centre according to the first 3 (or 4) digits in your voter ID card number.
- If you have lost your voter ID card, bring any legal ID card with photo (e.g. passport, National ID Card, driving license, NASSIT ID). If NEC polling staff can identify you on the Final Register of Electors of the polling centre where you registered, you will be able to vote.
- Polling will start at 7: 00 AM and close at 5:00 PM.
- Go to the polling centre **early** so that you can cast your vote in time.
- Follow the NEC polling staff instructions. Please remember that many Sierra Leoneans will exercise their right to vote on polling day. Please be patient, as you may have to wait in line for some time to be processed.
- Once your name is successfully found on the Final Register of Electors, you will receive **four (4)** ballots from the NEC polling staff; of the first set, one is for the election of President of Sierra Leone, the other is for the Parliamentary seat in the constituency in which your polling centre is located. Of the second set, one is for the election of Mayor/Chairperson and the other one is for councillors in the ward which your polling centre is located
- Remember to mark your ballots in the space beside the name and symbol of the candidates you wish to vote for.
- After you vote, you should leave the polling centre immediately.
- Keep your voter ID card safe! You may need it to vote again if there is a run-off for the election of the President of Sierra Leone
